

# **2011 Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo Royalty Code of Conduct Agreement**

- 1) Conduct yourself as a lady at all times, whether in Queen attire or not, when representing the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo. This includes behaving in a polite and gracious manner at all times. The Queen should never be seen arguing with anyone (this includes family). Yelling and acting out towards others is considered inappropriate behavior. The Queen must remember that she is in the public eye and is expected to represent the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo properly.
- 2) The Queen and her Attendants are expected to attend all required events in a punctual manner.
- 3) Mandatory appearances are a must. If for any reason you have to be absent from an event during your reign, you will be allowed **two** excused absences. ***This excludes Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo week.*** Any more absences have to be approved by the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo Committee.
- 4) The Queen/Attendant is allowed to attend events that are not required, as long as they are ran through the Queen Coordinators. Under NO circumstances should the Queen or anyone outside the Dinosaur Roundup Queen Coordinators call to set up an outside event.
- 5) If the Queen/Attendant or her family has questions or issues those must first be directed through the Queen Coordinators. If the Queen Coordinators are unable to correct those issues or answer the question, they will then consult the rodeo committee board members to reach an answer or solution.
- 6) The Queen/Attendant and her horse must always be appropriately groomed and well turned out. This also includes clipping and washing of the horse. The Queens/Attendants horse must show good care and the Queen/Attendant must remember this at all events.
- 7) The Queens/Attendants tack, no matter how old or new should also be clean and show good care. This includes checking tack often for any needed repairs.
- 8) No boyfriends will be allowed to drive the Queen or Attendants around. The royalties should either be driven by a legal guardian or ride together if possible.
- 9) The Queen will always wear the designated attire when representing the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo. This includes colored jeans, a belt, and Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo buckle (and crown if Queen). Appropriate boots with a heel, hat and long sleeve shirts that match the rest of her attire. Clothing should be clean and pressed and in good condition. All clothing should be modest and tactfully worn. Hair and makeup should be nicely, tastefully done and freshened throughout the day. The Queen/Attendants should also wear her sash. Throughout the reign all royalties need to wear Wrangler or

western affiliated jeans in good condition at all appearances unless otherwise noted. The Queen/Attendant should have no visible tattoos or excessive piercings.

- 10) The Queen/Attendant should always remember that even when not in official attire, she is in the public eye. This means that swearing, vulgarity, crude remarks, smoking, chewing tobacco, illegal drug use, and drinking alcoholic beverages are inappropriate and not acceptable.
- 11) Always remember to handle your horse as a horsewoman. All training and discipline should be done at home or in lessons. If discipline is needed it should be done in a tactful and inconspicuous manner.
- 12) The Queen/Attendant in no way should display any affection with a significant other. This includes, but is not limited to; kissing, handholding, and sitting on laps. The Queen/Attendant should also not live with a significant other.
- 13) The Queen should not run for any other title during her reign unless it is an upgrade from the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo Title. (.i.e Miss Rodeo Utah)
- 14) If the Queen is a minor (under 18), she should be supervised by a chaperone or parent at all times (excluding boyfriends).
- 15) The following is the property of the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo Committee and will be returned in good condition within a week of completion of her reign or immediately upon dismissal-
  - Crown
  - Serape if available
  - Chaps if available
  - Breast Collars if available

***If these items are not returned or are lost, stolen, or damaged the Queen/Attendant will replace it at the cost of the item that it will be replaced with.***

- 16) *The Queen and Jr. Queen crowns will be traveling crowns and be handed down the night of coronation to the new Queen.*
- 17) The Queen/Attendant will refrain from slandering others. The Queen/Attendant must avoid ALL inappropriate behavior and or language. This includes all information and slanderous remarks made via text, phone, photos, internet chat, twitter, myspace, or facebook, etc.
- 18) *It should also be remembered that representing the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo is supposed to be fun and a positive learning experience. It should also be taken into account that we all make mistakes, thus the following clause will be included. There will be a “Three strikes and you’re out” policy. This will be strictly enforced. If the Queen Coordinators feel the Queen/Attendant is in violation of this contract in any form or manner then she will be given a written warning***

**stating what the Rodeo Coordinators feel is inappropriate. The written warning must be signed by the Queen/Attendant and given back to a Queen Coordinator stating that she has been warned. After three warnings the Queen/Attendant will lose her title. There are no exceptions and this will be strictly enforced!**

- 19) The experience as Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo Queen/Attendant can be as fulfilling as you want to make it. It is entirely up to the Queen/Attendant as to how much or how little she experiences. The Queen Coordinators are your aid to determining your experiences over the next year. It is expected that the Queen/Attendant and her family respect the opinion and decisions made by the Queen Coordinators. Failure to comply with Queen Coordinators will result in a warning and potential loss of title. This is something that leaves no room for negotiation.
- 20) At this time there will be **NO** reimbursements for travel expenses.
- 21) This contract will be strictly enforced! The board members have all voted upon and approved this contract. By signing this contract you are agreeing to all parts of this contract. You also are in complete understanding of what is expected over the next year. The Queen/Attendant and her family fully understand that breaking ANY part of this contract can result in the Queen/Attendant losing her title.
