Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo
Royalty Code of Conduct Agreement

- 1) Conduct yourself as a lady at all times, whether in queen attire or not, when representing the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo. This includes behaving in a polite and gracious manner at all times. The queen should never be seen arguing with anyone (this includes family). Yelling and acting out towards others is considered inappropriate behavior. The queen must remember that she is in the public eye and is expected to represent the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo properly.
- 2) The queen and attendants are expected to attend all required events in a punctual manner.
- 3) The queen is allowed to attend events that are not required as long as they are run through the queen coordinators. Under NO circumstances should the queen or anyone outside of the Dinosaur Roundup Queen Coordinators call to set up an outside event.
- 4) If the queen, attendants, or their families have questions or issues those must first be directed through the queen coordinators. If the queen coordinators are unable to correct those issues or answer the question, they will then consult the rodeo committee board members to reach an answer or solution.
- 5) The queen/ attendant and her mount must always be appropriately groomed and well turned out. The queen/ attendants' mount must show good care and the queen/attendant must remember this at all events. The queen/attendant should have no visible tattoos or piercing with the exception of having one piercing in the ears.
- 6) The queen/attendant will always wear the designated attire when representing the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo. This includes colored jeans, belt, Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo buckle, appropriate boots with a heel, hat and long sleeve shirt that matches the rest of her attire. Clothing should be clean and pressed. All clothing should be modest and tactfully worn. Hair and makeup should be nicely and tastefully done. The queen/attendants should also wear her sash.
- 7) The queen/attendant's tack, no matter how old or new should also be clean and show good care. This includes checking tack often for any needed repairs.
- 8) The queen and her affiliates should always remember that even when not in official attire, she is in the public eye. This means that swearing, vulgarity, crude remarks, smoking, chewing tobacco, illegal drug use, and drinking alcoholic beverages are inappropriate.
- 9) Always remember to handle your horse as a horsewoman. All training and discipline should be done at home or in lessons. If discipline is needed it should be done in a tactful and inconspicuous manner.
- 10) The queen and her affiliates should, in no way, display any affection with a significant other. This includes but is not limited to kissing, handholding, and sitting on laps. The queen should also not live with a significant other.
- 11) The queen should not run for any other title during her reign unless it is an upgrade from the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo title. (i.e. Miss Rodeo Utah)

12) If the queen/attendant is a minor (under 18), she should be supervised by a chaperone/parent at all times.

13) The queen/attendant will refrain from slandering others. The queen/attendants must avoid all inappropriate behavior and or language. This includes all information and slanderous remarks made via text, phone, photos, internet chat, twitter, my space, face book, and etc.

14) The following is the property of the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo Committee and will be returned in good condition within a week of completion of her reign or immediately upon dismissal.

- Crown
- Serape if available
- Chaps if available
- Breast Collars if available

15) It should also be remembered that representing the Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo is supposed to be fun and a positive learning experience. It should also be taken into account that we all make mistakes, thus the following clause will be included. There will be a three strike and you're out policy. This will be strictly enforced. If the queen coordinators feel the queen or one of her affiliates is in violation of this contract in any form or manner then she will be given a written warning stating what the rodeo coordinators feel is inappropriate. The written warning must be signed by the queen/attendant, stating that she has been warned. After three warnings the queen/ attendant will lose her title. There are no exceptions and this will be strictly enforced!

16) The experience as Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo Royalty can be as fulfilling as you want to make it. It is entirely up to the queen/attendant as to how much or how little she experiences. The queen coordinators are your aid to determining your experiences over the next year. It is expected that the queen, her affiliates, and their families respect the opinion and decisions made by the queen coordinators. Failure to comply with queen coordinators will result in a warning and potential loss of title. This is something that leaves no room for negotiation.

17) Most importantly if you have questions, ASK! Call your queen coordinators and it will be up to them to answer questions or to find someone who can.

18) This agreement will be strictly enforced! The board members have all voted upon and approved this agreement. By signing this contract you are agreeing to all parts of this agreement. You also are in complete understanding of what is expected over the next year. The queen, attendants and their families fully understand that breaking ANY part of this agreement can result in the queen or one of her affiliates losing her title.
